At BB Performing Arts we reserve the right to dismiss any students and/or parents whose attitude, conduct or payment record is found to be unsatisfactory.

Attendance

Students are expected to regularly attend classes and be READY to dance at their allotted time. Repeated lateness or absence may hinder the student's progress. As a matter of courtesy, please notify us of any absence due to illness, school commitment or holiday.

Payment of Fees/Notice to Stop for Saturday School.

Fees must be paid by the date given on the invoice or a 10% fee will be added to your bill. Please speak to Miss Sarah IMMEDIATELY if you have any problems with the fees.

Notification to withdraw from any class must be given in writing via email half a term in advance. Otherwise you will be required to pay that amount, in lieu.

If fees are not paid by the allotted time, our insurance policy will not cover your child to be taught in class. This may result in them not participating in the class and sitting watching.

All Classes at Holy Cross are paid through the Agora System and all Saturday classes/ uniform/ exam fees go directly to BB Performing Arts.

Cancellation Policy

In adverse weather conditions, parents will be notified through the website or Facebook page as soon as possible. Generally we aim to make up the classes at a later stage or a refund.

If a teacher is unable to teach due to personal circumstances we will aim to cover the class with a different teacher or you will receive a refund.

Dress Code

"If you don't look like a dancer you won't feel like a dancer"

It is important that dancers wear the correct uniform so that the teacher can clearly see body lines and thereby make any necessary corrections.

All pupils are encouraged to take pride in their uniform and the way they wear it.

Please be aware that poorly-fitting uniform can be distracting, especially for younger children-they simply focus on what they are wearing and not on the teacher.

Students must adhere to the dress code at ALL TIMES, with hair in the correct styles: Ballet - bun
